“El Eternauta, Daytripper, and Beyond examines the graphic narrative tradition in the two South American countries that have produced the medium’s most significant and copious output. Argentine graphic narrative emerged in the 1980s, awakened by Héctor Oesterheld’s groundbreaking 1950s serial El Eternauta. After Oesterheld was “disappeared” under the military dictatorship, El Eternauta became one of the most important cultural texts of turbulent mid-twentieth-century Argentina. Today its story, set in motion by an extraterrestrial invasion of Buenos Aires, is read as a parable foretelling the “invasion” of Argentine society by a murderous tyranny. Because of El Eternauta, graphic narrative became a major platform for the country’s cultural redemocratization. In contrast, Brazil, which returned to democracy in 1985 after decades of dictatorship, produced considerably less analysis of the period of repression in its graphic narratives. In Brazil, serious graphic narratives such as Fábio Moon and Gabriel Bá’s Daytripper, which explores issues of modernity, globalization, and cross-cultural identity, developed only in recent decades, reflecting Brazilian society’s current and ongoing challenges. Besides discussing El Eternauta and Daytripper, David William Foster utilizes case studies of influential works—such as Alberto Breccia and Juan Sasturain’s Perramus series, Angélica Freitas and Odyr Bernardi’s Guadalupe, and others—to compare the role of graphic narratives in the cultures of both countries, highlighting the importance of Argentina and Brazil as anchors of the production of world-class graphic narrative.

Analiza mas de 300 historietas por sus contenidos, su estetica y su contexto sociopolitico. Recorre las revistas y diarios de todo el siglo XX, desde "Caras y Caretas" hasta "Fierro" y desde "Critica" hasta "Perfil.." Pasando, por supuesto, por las publicaciones de Columba, Record, La Urraca y las miticas de Editorial Frontera. Entre los trabajos analizados pueden verse desde las obras clasicas de Oesterheld, Pratt, Salinas y Breccia, hasta verdaderas perlas desconocidas. Aparecen, entre muchos, "Los ojos del Miron," la obra surrealista de principios de siglo de Raul Roux; los personajes unidimensionales de Lino Palacio, Adolfo Mazzone y Guillermo Divito; las absurdas fantasias de Garcia Ferre y Hector Torino, las sagas populares de Robin Wood y el costumbrismo de Trillo y Altuna en "El Loco Chavez." Todo hasta llegar a los innovadores autores contemporaneos como Carlos Nine, Rep y Max Cachimba. This is a psychedelically drawn, boldly political retelling of the 1950s graphic novel The Eternaut, whose imagery is still used as a symbol of resistance in Latin America to this day. The 1950s version of The Eternaut, a seminal Argentine work, is drawn in F. Solano Lopez's clean,

orderly comics art style. In the 1969 reboot, the darker tone is reflected in Breccia's Expressionist art. In *The Eternaut* 1969, the great world powers have forsaken South America to alien invaders, and POV character Juan Salvo, along with his friend Professor Favalli, metalworker Franco, and neighbor Susanna, join the resistance in Buenos Aires with the knowledge that the outside world will not come to their aid. Through the lenses of these timeless characters, the politically prescient creators ask readers to consider the implications of global domination by the "great powers" before it's too late.

Extracto: El indio Patoruzu, creado por Dante Quinterno en 1928, es uno de los personajes más importantes e influyentes de la historieta argentina. Nacido como secundario en dos tiras cómicas de corta vida, el cacique Patoruzu -el último de los tehuelches, a los que los conquistadores españoles habían visto en su momento como gigantes dotados de fuerza prodigiosa- obtuvo en poco tiempo su propia historieta, que daría origen a la revista homónima, uno de los grandes hitos del humor gráfico en Argentina. Quinterno dibujó historias originales intermitentemente durante casi cuarenta años, y las reimpresiones fueron numerosas. Desde los años '40 y años '50 del s.XX se transformó en uno de los iconos de la cultura popular argentina. La identidad de Patoruzu sufrió varios retoques durante los primeros años. Comenzó como un personaje humilde, taciturno e ignorante, a cargo de un tutor porteño de más educación; las historietas iniciales emplearon este contraste para destacar la paralela diferencia de actitudes entre el malicioso tutor, que daría eventualmente lugar a otro personaje duradero, Isidoro Canones, y el bondadoso e ingenuo indio. Sin perder la esquemática contraposición moral, Quinterno retocaría posteriormente la historia, transformando a Patoruzu en un poderoso aunque benevolente estanciero.
